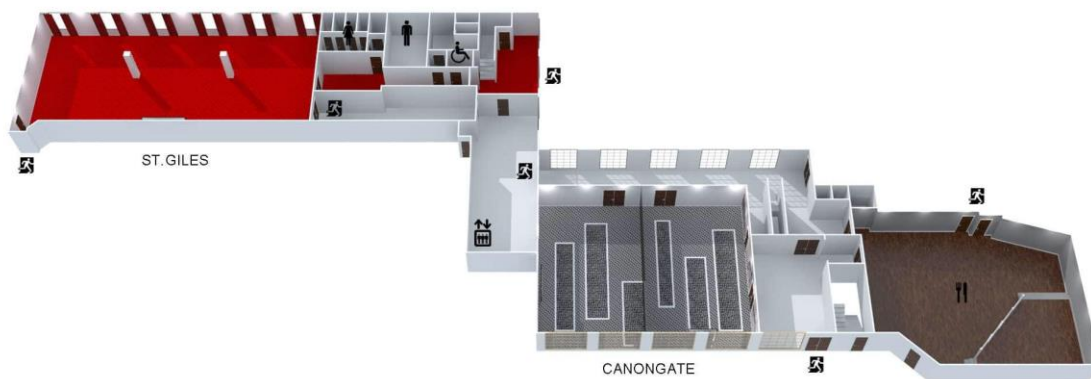
Exhibition Space: The Exhibitors lounge will occupy the St Giles Suite, with stands positioned around the outside edge. To ensure delegates spend time in the Exhibitors lounge, tea/coffee and lunch buffet tables will be located there.

Important information for exhibitors

- A small table will be provided for each exhibitor.
- Exhibitors must provide their own free-standing display stand.
- The hotel does not permit exhibitors to attach display materials to the walls.
- There are sufficient sockets around the outside edge of the room for all exhibitors to have a power supply.
- Access to set-up stands is from 8.30am and must be ready by 11pm. The conference will finish at around 4pm.

Location: The Radisson Blu is a quick 250 meter walk from Edinburgh Waverly Railway Station and a 10 minute walk from the Princes Street tram stop.

The conference will be held on the lower ground floor of The Radisson Blu Hotel with exhibitors in the St Giles Suite. There is direct access to this level for larger exhibition material



Parking: There is parking at the hotel. You can park at the Radisson Blu Hotel, Edinburgh City Centre. They have space for 131 vehicles, available on a first come, first served basis. When approaching the hotel southwards from Princes Street, turn left from North Bridge and continue to the first set of traffic lights. Turn right down St Mary's Street, then take your first right at the traffic lights onto the Cowgate, and then right up Blackfriars Street.
